### A BILL

To restore the jurisdiction of the Consumer Product Safety Commission over amusement park rides which are at a fixed site, and for other purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the `National Amusement Park Ride Safety Act of 2007'.

### SEC. 2. JURISDICTION OVER FIXED SITE AMUSEMENT RIDES.

Section 3(a)(1) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2052(a)(1)) is amended by striking ` , and which is not permanently fixed to a site. Such term does not include such a device which is permanently fixed to a site.' and inserting a period.

### SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

There are authorized to be appropriated to the Consumer Product Safety Commission \$500,000 for each fiscal year to enable the Commission to carry out the Consumer Product Safety Act as amended by this Act.
